
PARENT QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS – 2016

In December 2016, we conducted a questionnaire for our parents in order to gather information and views on what we are doing well and how we can continue to improve as a school.

Parents responded to each question by placing an **X** in the box which best described your views.

The results were then collated and calculated as a percentage. There were a total of 41 returned questionnaires and parents responded to most questions, but several were left blank.

My child enjoys coming to school - **99%** of families asked either agreed or strongly agreed.

My child is safe at school - **100%** of our families believe their child is safe in school – with one parent commenting.

The school understands and responds to my child's needs - **89%** either agreed or strongly agreed.

My child is taught well at school - 96% agreed/strongly agreed that their child is taught well at school.

My child is making good progress - 91% agreed/strongly agreed.

My child is encouraged to work hard and do their best - 86% agreed/strongly agreed.

My child receives appropriate homework for his/her age - 66% following the questionnaire we have reviewed our homework and will be introducing some more formal, written methods for maths. All children to read daily, practice spelling rules issued weekly, complete topic homework and complete weekly maths (online or written).

My child enjoys a stimulating range of extra- curricular activities - 76% we continually review our extra-curricular activities and, since the questionnaire, we have introduced cheerleading. All parents have been made aware of the variety of clubs that are available including when they are on. We also offer music tuition. We also ensure that extra-curricular events in the local community are shared with our families.

The school communicates with me about my child's progress - 84% are happy with the way that we communicate about progress. We continue to meet the statutory requirements every term either through parents' consultation meetings or end of year reports. We also ensure that any issues are shared with parents as appropriate. We pride ourselves on being available to discuss individual progress with parents, as appropriate.

The school informs me effectively about school events and activities - **98% agree/strongly agree.**

The school seeks my views and listens to my concerns - **81% Parent questionnaires are sent out to seek parental views and this will continue.**

Standards of behaviour are high at Hockley Heath Academy - **93% agreed/strongly agreed. We pride ourselves on excellent behaviour.**

The school deals with any incidents of bullying effectively - **76% none of our parents disagreed/strongly disagreed. Comments from the questionnaires suggest that the 24% that ticked 'don't know' had no experiences with bullying and therefore cannot comment. There are currently no reported bullying incidents and any "friendship issues" are dealt with immediately and recorded.**

The school is welcoming and there are opportunities to get involved - **98% agreed/strongly agreed. We pride ourselves on a positive and welcoming ethos.**

I think the school is well led and managed - **93%**

My child is encouraged to lead a healthy lifestyle - **91% through our curriculum, we encourage our children to be healthy through healthy eating, exercise and positive attitudes to support mental health.**

I would recommend Hockley Heath Academy to another family - **98%**

Hockley Heath Academy is well thought of in the local community - 93% as the heart of the community, we are proud that 93% of our families think highly of us.
